The Walkabout was to identify environmental issues.

**Issue of weeds** - on street was raised and this was identified as the first herbicide treatment being undertaken in the north of the area advised that this was underway in the wider area with manual removal being undertaken as well.

**Redundant notices on lampposts** - were raised as an issue and we will make arrangements for a sweep of the area where these plus ties will be removed (once festival is over).

**Redundant sign** - for Lyndoch Nursing home on Queensferry Road opposite Drumsheugh Gardens to be removed.

**Advertising Board** at the Kelpies to be removed (now done).

**Huxley Area** – Update required (**Iain McPhail**)

**Wall at Coates and Athol Crescents** - update required as to what the approach was taken to retain stone and patch up? (Letter attached)

**Douglas Gardens** - flooding during heavy rain (check with Gullies Team and get cleared if required).

**Eglinton Crescent** - capacity issue with people walking around the corner to use bins from Palmerston Place check whether an other bin can be sited on the DYL.

**Drumsheugh Gardens** - footway repairs required outside Bonham Hotel.
